

// PERMIT REQUIREMENTS BRIEF · FILE DC-CPL-101

District of Columbia Concealed Pistol License (CPL)

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Issuing authority	DC Metropolitan Police Department (MPD) — Firearms Registration Branch
Minimum age	21 years old
Residency	Open to DC residents and non-residents (must hold a valid pistol registration if a DC resident)
Training hours	16 hours classroom + 2 hours range = 18 hours total
Application fee	\$75 (new) / \$75 (renewal)
Fingerprint fee	\$35 (DC MPD fingerprinting)
Renewal cycle	Every 2 years
Processing time	Approximately 90 days

QUALIFICATION

DC MPD-approved range qualification course of fire

DISQUALIFIERS

- Felony or misdemeanor crime of violence conviction
- Conviction for two or more DUIs in the past 5 years
- Adjudicated mentally ill (within 5 years)
- Restraining or stalking order
- Currently in drug or alcohol treatment
- Under 21

WHAT TO BRING

- Valid government-issued photo ID
- Completed PD-301 application form
- Two passport photos
- DC pistol registration certificate (DC residents)

- Proof of completed training
- Eye and ear protection (range)

ADDITIONAL NOTES

DC has extensive 'sensitive places' restrictions: federal property, public transit, parks, schools, polling places, restaurants serving alcohol, etc. Off-body holster carry is not permitted.
